Institute : Registration Process



SII aims to provide international students with learning opportunities in reputed educational institutes. To ensure the same, SII programme strictly partners with institutes that are eligible as per the following norms :

1. Listed/ figured in the NIRF
2. A valid NAAC score of 3.01 on scale of 4.0
3. Institutes granted the status of Institution of National Importance or Institute of Eminence
4. Listed in QS World Ranking Asia 2024 onwards
5. Accorded Autonomous Status by any statutory bodies, Ministries viz., MHA, AICTE, UGC, NMC, NCI, etc. of the Government of India.
6. Institutions with 80% admissions consecutively for the last 5 Academic Years.

Study in India is also accepting Foreign institutes having Indian Campuses under the criteria :

1. Foreign institutes having Indian Campus Approved under UGC guidelines
2. Foreign institutes having Indian Campus Approved for GIFT City (Gujarat International Finance Tech-City) by IFSCA (International Financial Services Centres Authority)

Note : We will need document for one of the above-mentioned eligibility criteria to approve your institute for partnership


- Institutes fulfilling the above-mentioned criteria, are requested to register with Study in India.
- Institutes which are registered with Study in India, can only intake foreign students & NRI.
- Foreign students will only be granted Student Visa, once the foreign student registers with Study in India & generate their unique SII ID, which will be used to track their admission, VISA & FRRO.

NOTE : Previously partnered institute of Study in India need not register again, their data has been already replicated to the new website.

Institute : Registration Process

Institutes can register & become a partner institute of Study in India by following a few basic steps:

- Visit the website : www.studyinindia.gov.in
- On the Right top side of the website, there is a Button “Register”
- Click on the “Register” Button & then click on “Institute Register”

- You will be redirected to the Institute Partnership page (URL: <https://www.studyinindia.gov.in/institute/partnership>)
- For Applying to becoming a partner institute with Study in India, all institute will need to submit Letter of Undertaking, their Institute Eligibility document & all the required fields.
- There is a sample of the “Letter of Undertaking” you will need to get it signed from your Head of Institute & the Nodal officer nominated for this Study in India programme. This Letter of undertaking format is already present in the starting of the page.
- Please fill all the fields mentioned on the page correctly to be considered for the partnership

- While mentioning your AISHE code, please cross verify it, as it will be your Login ID.
- If any institute does not know their AISHE Code, please check your AISHE Code on AISHE Website : <https://aishe.gov.in/aishe/aisheCode> (Check the link once)
- Please verify all your institute details while filling, as you will not be allowed to edit these details later.
- The Details about the institute filled here will be considered to approve/reject your institute for partnership with Study in India programme.
- **NOTE** : For Foreign Institutes having offshore campus in India, you need not mention your AISHE Code.

- Please upload the corresponding document to authenticate your Institute Status.
- If your institute has some other institute eligibility document i.e., point 4, 5 & 6 then, please upload that document in **Others** Section.
- If your institute falls under Foreign Institute with Offshore Campus in India category, then kindly upload *Regulatory approval from IFSCA (International Financial Services Centres Authority) & UGC (University Grants Commission) document in the section **“Offshore Campus”**
- Please download the Letter of Undertaking, complete it & get it signed from the Head of institute & compliance officer(your institute representative for SII program) & then upload it. (format is present).
- After submitting your application, please wait for a few days for SII team to review your registration.
- You will receive your login credentials on the registered Head of the Institute’s email ID.
